

Bring the actual works, up to 2 pieces, completed entry coupons, fee, (photographs for press releases, if possible) and a selfaddressed/stamped envelope to the Center on October 28, between 1-4pm. Each finished work can be no larger than 34x44 inches including frame. Framed multiples (i.e. diptychs, triptychs, etc.), when hung as a unit, cannot exceed 44 inches wide. Works *must* be professionally presented, framed and properly wired for hanging. Any piece larger than 16x20 should have plexi & a sturdy frame; otherwise, we cannot be responsible for breakage. For up to 2 works: \$20. Checks must be made out to Nancy Ori.
