

The Federation presents this honor to those who have advanced photography in the state of NJ. The Federation has established the policy of awarding public recognition to individuals who have made <u>major contribu-</u> <u>tions</u> to the advancement of the art and science of photography in the <u>State of New Jersey</u>.

This award is identified as the NJFCC Citation and it is the highest individual honor bestowed by the Federation.

Over the past 43 years there have been 110 recipients.


