GOOD NEWS FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS!

After more than a year of deliberation and discussions, with input from the public and the film industry, the Mayor's Office of Film, Theatre and Broadcasting (MOFTB) has finally adopted permit rules for photographing and filming in New York City.

Proposed rules were first published in May 2007, followed by a public hearing in June. The MOFTB received extensive comments through August. They then republished the rules for comment in October and received additional extensive comments. They held another public hearing on December 13, 2007 and, since that time, all comments received were reviewed as they prepared the final version of the rules. The final version was released last month on July 14th and is now in effect, as of August 13th.

The bottom line? "Permits will not be required for casual photographers, tourists, credentialed members of the media, or other members of the public who do not use vehicles or equipment or assert exclusive use of City property."
