NJFCC REIMBURSEMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

During the May 2012 delegates meeting the executive board formed a committee to come up with a plan to help member NJFCC clubs offset some of their expenses for the 2012-2013 camera club season. Our member clubs have helped make Photorama a great success over the last few years so the NJFCC wanted to give something back to all the member clubs as a way of saying thanks.

I take great pleasure in announcing that the committee has recommended a \$200 reimbursement per club to help offset speaker fees and the executive board and trustees have unanimously approved the resolution!!!

The funds can be used for multiple speaker fees. All that is required is that the member club submits a completed form. The member club can bring the form to the delegates meeting or e-mail it to our treasurer <u>Vinnie Kempf</u> and he will remit a check back to the club.On behalf of the past and present executive boards and trustees, I would like to thank our member clubs for supporting Photorama and with the clubs continued support we hope to make our <u>2013 Photorama</u> an even bigger success!

NJFCC EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND

Also, during the May 2012 delegates meeting President Gregory DeAngelis formed a committee to explore establishing an emergency relief fund to help financially struggling member clubs. The committee recommended that the NJFCC would set aside \$5,000 for the fund.

This fund would allow member clubs to draw a onetime \$500 grant. Member clubs requesting this grant must be members of the NJFCC for at least 1 year prior to the request. They must also submit a written letter to the NJFCC detailing the hardship behind it. Request for funds can be for any reason including but not limited to; equipment needs, unexpected facility fees, website presence, or any other financial hardship but a true need must be demonstrated by the club requesting the funds. Trustee approval will be required for the grant to be awarded and is limited to one grant per club for the life of the fund.

On behalf of the executive board and trustees I am proud to report that the executive board and trustees unanimously approved the recommendation.


