The New Jersey Federation of Camera Clubs presents an honor, the NJFCC Citation, and has established the policy of awarding public recognition to individuals who have made major contributions to the advancement of the art and science of photography. This award is the highest individual honor bestowed by the Federation.

The Citation Committee consists of John Sandstedt, NJFC, Chair; George Hall, NJFC; and a third member to be appointed.

To nominate a candidate two forms must be completed. The first, the Proposer's Form, presents the accomplishments of the nominee as describe by the Proposer. The second, the Endorser's Form, is an independent endorsement of the nominee by another party.

Copies of the instructions for nomination and the required Forms can be obtained from John Sandstedt at jsandstedt@comcast.net. Completed nomination documents must be returned to John Sandstedt . The deadline for receipt of the Proposer's Application and Endorser's Forms is February 15, 2014.

The recipient of the NJFCC Citation will be announced at Photorama 2015.
