The New Jersey Federation of Camera Clubs presents an honor, the NJFCC Citation, and has established the policy of awarding public recognition to individuals who have made major contributions to the advancement of the art and science of photography. This award is the highest individual honor bestowed by the Federation.

The Citation Committee consists of John Sandstedt, NJFC, Chair; George Hall, NJFC; and Greg DeAngelis.

To nominate a candidate two forms must be completed. The first, the Proposer's Form, presents the accomplishments of the nominee as describe by the Proposer. The second, the Endorser's Form, is an independent endorsement of the nominee by another party.

The deadline for receipt of the Proposer's Application and Endorser's Forms is February 15, 2014. The recipient of the NJFCC Citation will be announced at Photorama 2015.

It's not a photograph until you print it! The Canon Pixma PRO 100 and Canon Pixma PRO 10 Printers are on a huge mail in rebate through 2/28/2015.

Here is a <u>link to the Canon Pixma PRO 100 printer</u>. This is a fabulous value! We sell the printer for \$349.99 (\$499.99 on Canon's web site). If you buy the printer and one package of Canon 13x19", 50 sheets paper (\$50) luster or semi-gloss, Canon will send you a \$250 AMEX gift card rebate. You own the printer for \$99.99 plus the cost of the paper! The Pixma PRO 100 is WiFi and uses 8 color cartridges. It does an equally good job on black & white as well as color prints. It comes with a FULL set of inks (not a starter set).

The <u>Canon Pixma PRO 10</u> is a pigment ink printer that uses 10 cartridges, (PRO 100 is dye based). It sells for \$699.99 on Canon's web site. We sell it for \$449.99 and if you purchase the paper with it, Canon will send you a \$250 rebate. Your final cost is \$199.99 plus the paper (\$50). It is also WiFi equipped and comes with a full set of inks.

As an added special for anyone who purchases either of these printers from me, I can sell them a complete set of ink refills for \$114.99, (usually \$124.99) for the Pixma PRO 100 or \$124.99, (usually \$134.99), for the Pixma PRO 10.

If either printer is purchased, I can offer a bundle with <u>Adobe Lightroom 5</u> for just \$29.99, a \$149.99 value!

In order to produce good and consistent quality prints and not waste a lot of ink and paper, you should be calibrating your monitor. also If you calibrate your monitor, your output from the printer will match what you see on your screen. Calibration is not difficult or expensive. I can offer your members/students the ColorMunki Display Calibration Device from X-rite for \$159 (regularly \$169.00).
