SELF CRITIQUING



Don't be afraid to rip your own work apart. Have the guts to say, "This picture really stinks." Now figure out why it doesn't meet up with your definition of what comprises a good image and how you can do better next time. Also, share your work with others, but make sure they're the type who can offer constructive criticism. By that I mean other photo enthusiasts, pro photographers, or artists. If you truly want to shoot better shots and are willing to take the criticism, showing your photos to Aunt Sylvia just won't hack it. What you'll hear is, "Very nice. Ooh, look at how straight Bonnie's hair is in this picture!" That's not to say you shouldn't share your shots with friends or relatives in person or online. Just realize that these situations aren't meant to be a forum for improving your photo skills.

Finally, if you're ready to take the criticism, don't get defensive. You can have a conversation with the person beating you up, but don't become Mohammed Ali in defending your work. If all he hears is a bunch of "Yeah buts" such as "Yeah, but the focus is really good" or "Yeah, but look at how vibrant the colors are," the critique will be over...very quickly.

Remember, there's no right or wrong with art. The final word lies with you, the artist. If the whole world thinks that one of your shots is terrible, but you love it, then keep on loving it.

This photo stuff can be a lot of fun...especially if you're not doing it to put bread on table. So have fun with it. If it gets to be too much of a job, it's time to take a break. Go play golf or something. Just don't ask someone to criticize your swing.


