
We will be making plans for a northern NJ pick up location so that photographers living in that region do not have to travel too far to deliver their framed photographs.

## Hey, That's Funny! By Rick Berger HUB Camera Club

Do you want a real challenge? Try taking pictures that make people laugh. We "photo enthusiasts" as camera club members are called nowadays, strive to shoot pictures that evoke emotions. We want those looking at our images to experience any number of human reactions...joy, empathy, surprise, shock etc.

The one emotion that nobody seems to want his shots to evoke is laughter!

If you sit through a typical photo competition you'll see wonderful images of superb quality, shots often rivaling or even exceeding those of the professionals. How many of those shots were taken with the express purpose of making people laugh? How many bring any club members to emit so much as a giggle in the darkened room? Few, if any.

Those of you who know me know that in addition to being a professional photographer, I've had several other professional careers, one of which was as an entertainer. From personal experience I can unequivocally state that there's nothing harder in show business than to make an audience laugh. I'll go out on a limb here and proclaim that photographically speaking, there's nothing harder than to get those viewing your photo to laugh. So why is this? Do we take ourselves too seriously? Does shooting something funny make us any less of a photographer?

Camera clubs nationwide are currently grappling with the problem of whether they should introduce new categories into their competitions. Some have come to recognize that photographs can take on the attributes of graphic design and art and echo the looks of abstract art or surrealistic paintings. In order to accept and recognize these genres of photography some clubs have introduced categories such as "Creative" or "Altered Reality."

Another category currently being recognized and added into competitions is "Documentary" photography. This includes images that tell a story. This is certainly no new earth-shaking use of the photographic image. From the first shots made with a pinhole camera to photos we view today on our iPads, pictures continue to document our existence.

I challenge any club out there to take on a new category..."Humor." Being a realist, I know that this will never happen. Do you want to know why? For one thing they'll probably receive no entries in that category! Nobody wants to take the risk that a shot of his that was supposed to be funny gets no laughs when it's projected up there on the screen. On stage, I've had jokes bomb. It's not a good feeling, but with a quick recovery I was able to get 'em laughing again. In a camera club competition you can't immediately throw up another funny shot in the hopes that the members and judge will start laughing at your next shot.

Several clubs, in addition to their regular competitions, offer "contests" during the summer months when many folks are on vacation and traveling. Unlike regular competitions during the year, scores given to those who compete in these contests do not count toward yearly totals or advancement to a higher level. In these contests, the usual categories that are used all year (Nature, Open, Black and White etc.) are replaced with themes. The themes vary widely and may have titles such as "Rust," "Clouds," "Abandoned Buildings" etc. Perhaps this would be a good place to introduce the "Funny Photo" category. Of course, it's extremely "iffy" that this will ever take place in my lifetime.

However, I say, "Funny photographers unite!" For those of you with a sense of humor, raise your cameras up and photograph something funny out there, be it a masterpiece of photographic expression or a dumb old snapshot. It's been said that, "Laughter is the best medicine" and since a picture is worth a thousand words, perhaps a funny photo is the best medicine. I rest my case...my camera case, that is.


